3. The bidding companies/firms should have the following requirements:
 - (i) The Company should have valid permit/registration from a competent local authority for providing security services in Liberia.

 - (ii) The Company should have experience in providing security services for a minimum period of 5 years in Liberia.

 - (iii) The Company should be providing security services to the Diplomatic Missions/UN organizations and other well-known and reputed business entities in Liberia.

4. The quotation/bid along with duly filled-in Annexure-I and supporting documentary evidence should be submitted in a sealed envelope superscripted **“FOR HIRING OF SECURITY AGENCY FOR THE CHANCERY PREMISES OF THE EMBASSY OF INDIA, MONROVIA AND A RESIDENCE”** addressed to the **Head of Chancery, Embassy of India, No.16 & 18, Coconut Plantation, UN Drive, Monrovia** and must reach before 15.12.2025 by 1700 hrs. It should also be superscripted at the bottom left corner with the full name, postal address, email and telephone number of the firm/dealer. Bids may be hand delivered or sent by post at the aforementioned address so as to reach on or before the stipulated date and time. The Mission will not be responsible for any postal delay. Bidders should ensure that the technical and financial bids are sealed in separate covers duly superscribed and both the sealed covers are to be put in a bigger cover which should also be sealed and duly superscribed.

The bidder is required to deposit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of US\$ 800/- in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks or payment online in an acceptable form. The EMD should remain valid for a period of forty-five days beyond the final bid validity period. Bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract.

7. Quotation/bid and copies of the credentials/documents are required to be signed/self-attested by the applicant with official seal.

8. The bidder must fulfill the eligibility criteria as per the format specified at Annexure-I & II and submit along with its financial quotation as per our requirement and terms and conditions in Appendix-I. Financial bids of only technically qualified companies shall be evaluated.

9. The quotations/bids would be rejected due to incorporation of any false information and furnishing fake or truncated documents.

10. The validity of the quotation shall be at least 90 days from the last date of submission of bid.

11. Bid received after the closing date and time as prescribed in the tender notice, shall NOT be accepted under any circumstances.

12. The Embassy of India reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without giving any notice or assigning any reason and the decision of the Embassy in this regard shall be final and binding.

TENDER DOCUMENT

Section 1: Scope of Work

1. Sealed quotations are hereby invited by the Embassy of India in Monrovia from well reputed registered security agencies to provide **Two (02)** security guards on 27 x 7 basis i.e. one each at the Chancery Building of the Embassy of India, situated at No.16 & 18, Coconut Plantation, UN Drive, Monrovia and a residence situated at 7th street Sinkor, Monrovia.
2. All bidders for this tender are advised to understand the Chancery building's and residence's layout carefully before submitting the tender. The bidder will be responsible for any certifications, license, permits or compliances with the local authorities and Government of Liberia.
3. The bidder must fulfill the quality parameters listed in Annexure-I of the this tender document.
4. The bidder must ensure that security guards deployed by it, fulfill the parameters listed in Annexue-II of the this tender document.
5. The bidder must invite the team of the Embassy to visit the training facility used by them to train the pool of security guards deployed by them.

Section 2: Terms and Conditions

1. Subject to the acceptance of the bid and any counter offer by the Embassy of India, the successful bidder shall enter into a contract with the Embassy of India, that will comprise statement of conditions, rates and payment terms, specification of the security services to be provided etc.
2. The initial Contract shall be valid for a period of two years (02 years). No escalation of service charges during the period of contract. The contract may be further extended by another year on on same terms and conditions and same rates, subject to satisfactory services provided by the provider. Either party can terminate the Contract by giving another party a month written notice.
3. Bidder must submit the following together with the tender documents:
 - i Suitable documentation to show the company's experience (minimum 5 years) in providing security services to reputed organizations (such as company brochure, appointment list & reference letter etc.)
 - i Broad financial and other details of the company including organization chart to show the company's management system and back up support for security services provided in the Building.
4. The bidder shall ensure services on 24 x 7 basis for the entire duration of contract with sufficient provision for back-up personnel in case of any urgency. The agency must inform the Embassy and residents of any change in deployment in advance.
5. The bidder is required to deposit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of US\$ 800/- in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks or payment online in an acceptable form. The EMD (Appendix-II) should remain valid for a period of forty-five days beyond the final bid validity period. Bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract.
6. Penalties, if any required, will be levied as per Annexure-III of this tender document.
7. Performance Security: To ensure due performance of the contract, the successful bidder shall be required to furnish Performance Security of 3% of the value of contract after award of the contract. Performance Security may be furnished in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt from a Commercial bank, Bank Guarantee from a Commercial bank or online payment in an acceptable form. Performance Security should remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including warranty obligations. EMD will be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of Performance Security. The Performance Security furnished in the form of an Account Payee

Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt from a Commercial bank, Bank Guarantee from a Commercial bank or online payment, shall be returned interest-free post expiry of its validity. The proforma for Performance Security is as per Appendix-III of the tender document.

8. The bidder shall furnish performance reports of the deployed personnel, on regular basis.
9. The bidder shall be paid on a monthly basis for the services rendered in the preceding month. The payment will be made either through Bank Transfer or Account Payee Cheque after rendering services and receipt of the invoice in this regard.
10. If a firm quotes NIL charges/consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
11. The contract shall be awarded to technically qualified lowest bidder.
12. The contractor will be bound by non-disclosure agreement for confidentiality and secrecy as per Appendix-IV of the tender document.

QUALITY PARAMETERS FOR SERVICE PROVIDER COMPANIES

This list pertains to ten parameters against which bidders shall provide detailed information in descriptive terms along with supporting documents and records. Each parameter will be evaluated on a scale of 10 and marks will be awarded accordingly. Only financial bids (Appendix – I) of those companies shall be considered, who score marks more than the cut-off benchmark. The average of the marks obtained by top two Bidders will be considered as the cut-off bench mark.

1. List of other clients, the bidder is serving in terms of supply of SGs in Liberia and other countries to ascertain the level of global security knowledge and experience the bidder has.
2. Past experience, service history, achievements of the company.
3. Evidence of registration of the company under relevant statutory regulations such as labour laws applicable in the host country (if registered under more than one law, the same be furnished).
4. Evidence of range of security services provided.
5. Size of the reserve pool of men and logistics such as response teams, patrol vehicles security equipments / control room facilities / communication equipments under use etc.
6. Attrition rate of security guards and security supervisors (the average period for which a security guard remains with the company).
7. Training Facilities: Does the company have its own training facility (details thereof)? Does it avail the facility of another provider or a company that only focuses on training? What is the curriculum and duration of training of the security guards and the supervisors?
8. Industry certification obtained by the company for its quality & Company's relationship with local police.
9. Scope and limit of liability of the company.
- 10 Take home pay and allowances of the security guards (with payslips/ copies of cheques or proof of online transfer of salary).

QUALITY PARAMETERS FOR SECURITY GUARDS (SGs)

These parameters pertain to personal qualities and attributes of LSGs, who are to be provided by the bidder. The bidder in their technical bids must agree to comply with these parameters and must providing an undertaking for it. These quality parameters are our critical minimum requirement and any inability to meet any or all of these would make bidder liable for rejection at the technical bid stage only. Needless to say, failure to comply with any of the parameters mentioned in the list subsequent to the award of the contract to a bidder at a later stage during the contract period, would entitle the Embassy to terminate the contract.

1. SGs should not be more than 50 years of age and the Supervisor, wherever necessary, should not be more than 55 years of age.
2. Should be physically and mentally fit and should not be suffering from an apparent disability. The Provider should submit Medical Fitness Certificate i.r.o every SG from an authorized Medical Practitioner. Additionally, he / she should not be emaciated, feeble and timid in an apparent sense.
3. Should have been vetted by local Government's security department(s) in terms of past record, character and antecedents. The Provider should provide background details of the LSGs and also proof of their vetting.
4. Should possess training in basic security duties such as access control and anti-sabotage checks (of persons, baggage and vehicles) including use of basic security tools such as HHMD, DFMD, CCTV monitoring, baggage and letter scanners etc.
5. Should have attended education at least upto 10th Grade or matriculation equivalent.
6. Should be proficient in the local language (so as to deal with local visitors and unruly persons or group of persons). Should be in possession of minimum English language skills required to communicate with the Embassy staff.
7. Should perform duties in smart uniform and their overall appearance should be neat and clean.
8. Should be thoroughly proficient and trained in handling of arms and other security equipments they are supposed to carry or use.

Note: The Provider should have a system of undertaking supervisory checks of functioning of SGs to ensure that the supplied SGs are discharging their duties with efficiency and as per the SOPs designed by the Embassy. The Provider should clearly spell out as to what will be the system of supervision/surprise checks so as to achieve the above objective e.g. number of scheduled and surprise visits in a given period.
