Know India Programme is a flagship programme of Ministry of External Affairs for engagement with Indian origin youth (between 18-30 years) (Not for Indian Passport Holders) to enhance their awareness about India, its cultural heritage, art and to familiarise them with various aspects of contemporary India. The Government has announced three Know India Programmes (60th, 61st & 62nd) on the KIP Portal (www.kip.gov.in). The last date of registration for 60th KIP is 19th July, 2022, 61st KIP: 19 August, 2022 and 62nd KIP: 23rd September, 2022. Minimum qualification required for participating in KIP is graduation from a recognized University /Institute or enrolled for graduation and ability to speak in English.

- 2. The eligible applicants from Liberia who are interested in above KIP programmes may like to register themselves and apply on the KIP portal at www.kip.gov.in. In the Application Form, the applicant should indicate his/her preference for each KIP, in the order or priority. Ministry will attempt to allot the first preference of each applicant to the extent possible. For more details-please-visit www.kip.gov.in.
- 3. Participants are provided local hospitality e.g. boarding and Internal transportation in India, return air tickets from their country of residence to India provided participants bear 10% of the cost of total air fare. Kindly note that "no application of an applicant will be considered for these KIPs, if the said applicant had already visited India under any of the schemes funded by the Government of India." Applicant must provide documentary evidence to prove Indian origin or an undertaking about Indian origin which must be countersigned by Embassy of India, Monrovia.
